

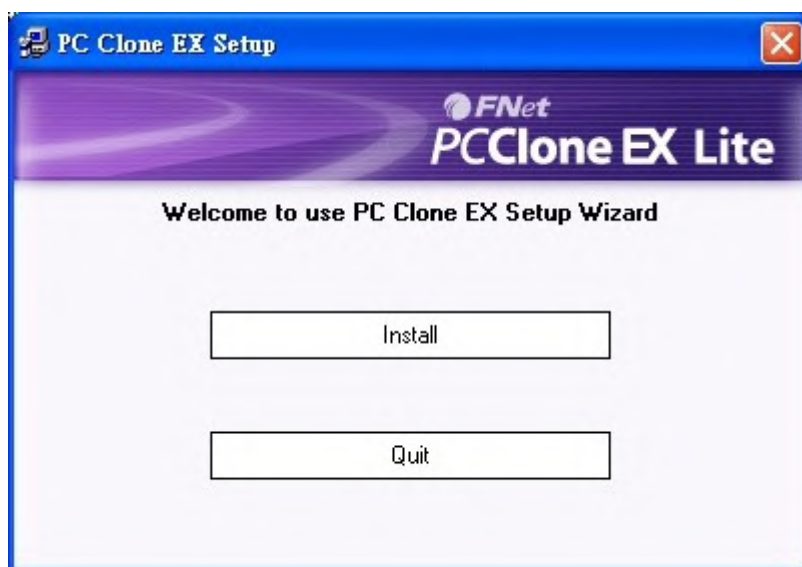
ONE TOUCH BACKUP - User's Guide



System Requirements

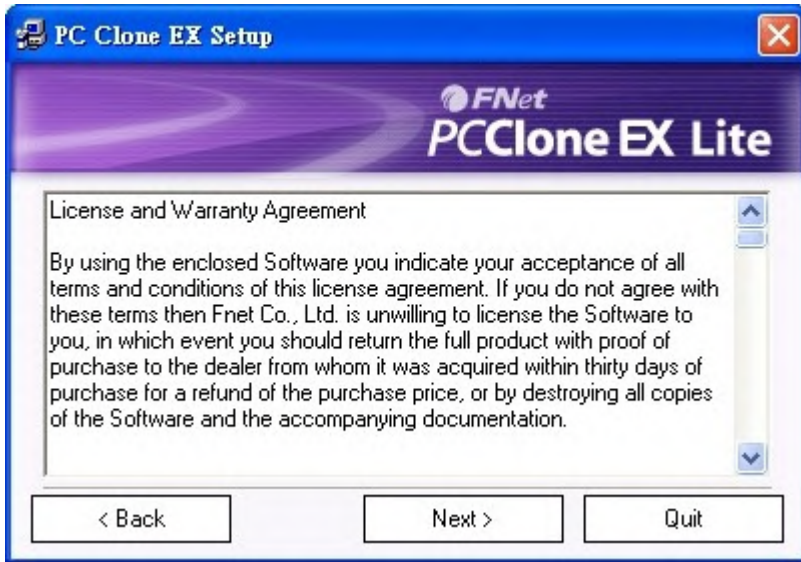
- Pentium computers or 100% compatible computers.
- Support OS: Microsoft Windows 2000 / XP / Vista / 7.
- CPU Pentium or above.
- 128 MB RAM.
- Display card: compatible with VESA standard.
- An external USB hard disk.

Software installation

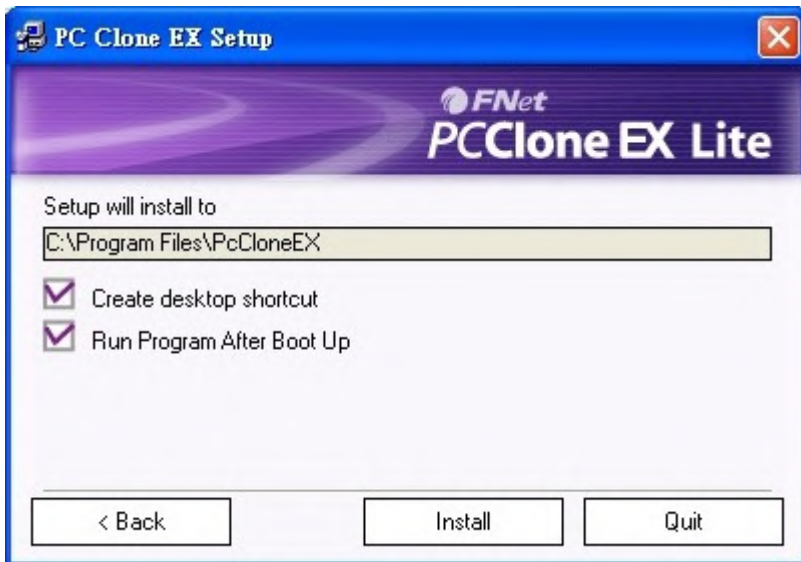


1. Please put PCClone EX Lite CD into CD ROM drive and launch the Setup.exe
2. Click on Install to initiate installation process and Quit to cancel.

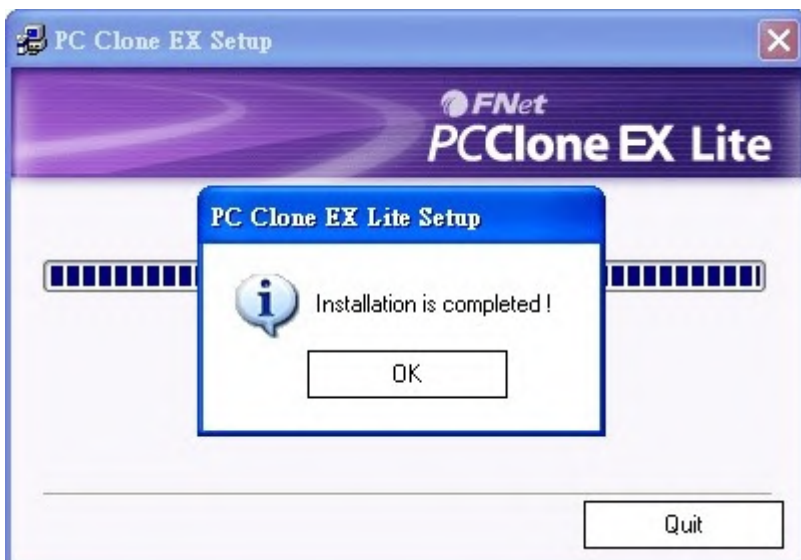




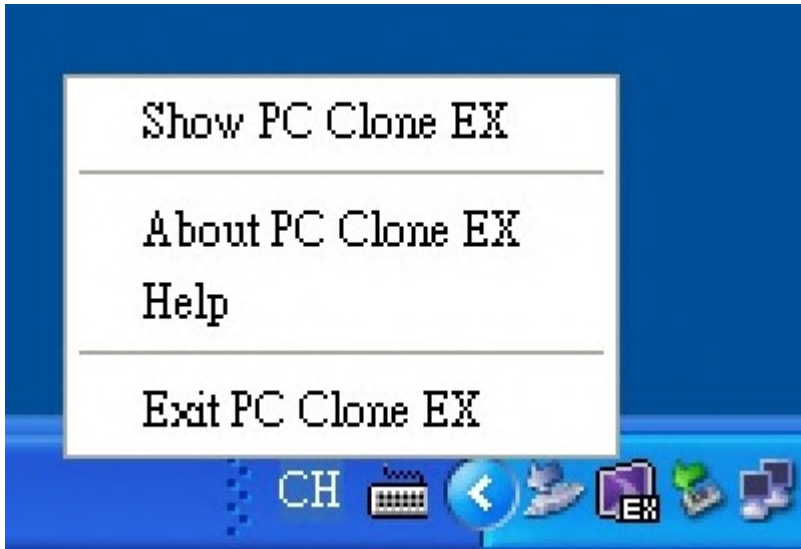
3. Please read the license agreement in detail.
4. If users accept the agreement, please click Next to install.



5. Please specify the installation path of PCClone EX Lite.
6. A check mark will be placed at "Create Desktop Shortcut" option by default. Remove the check mark if necessary.
7. Click on "Install" to proceed or "Quit" to cancel action.



8. The installation process should only take a few moments. A dialog box will pop up when it is completed, please click OK to exit installation.



9. PCClone EX icon will displays in the notification area after setup. Users can double click the icon or press the right key of the mouse to execute PCClone EX Lite.

One Touch Button File Backup

This function allows user to backup selected folder(s)/file(s) by only pressing OTB button on USB HDD.

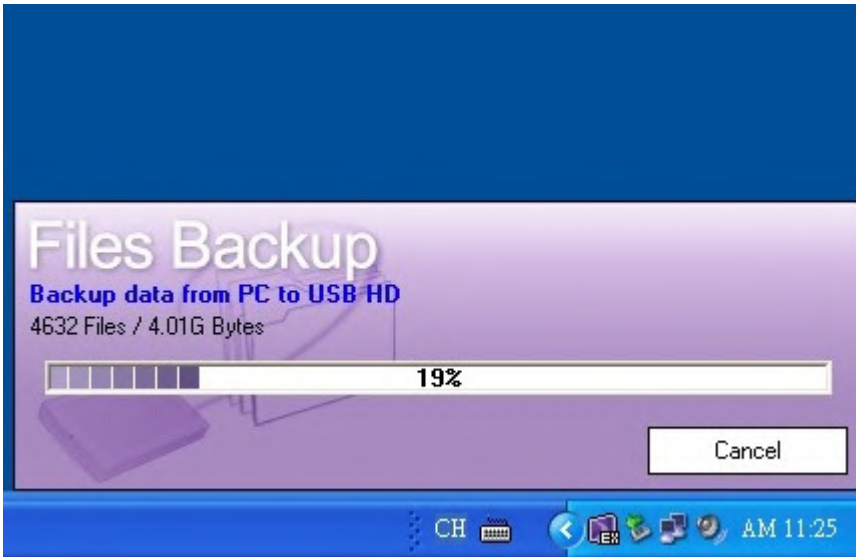
Note: PCClone EX icon must be present at the desktop notification area before the OTB button on USB HDD is pressed. For first time use, please refer to [File Backup](#) session for selecting preferred files to back up and [File Backup Setting](#) for hotkey setup.



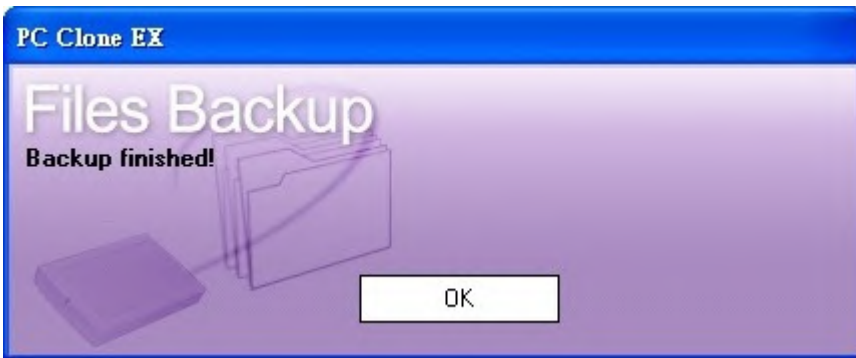
1. Please make sure that USB HDD is connected to the host computer and its power is ON.
2. Click on [PCCloneEX](#) desktop shortcut to execute program.
3. Just press the OTB button on the external case.



4. A dialog box will pop out confirming the File backup action. Click on [Start](#) or press the OTB button on USB HDD again to continue.

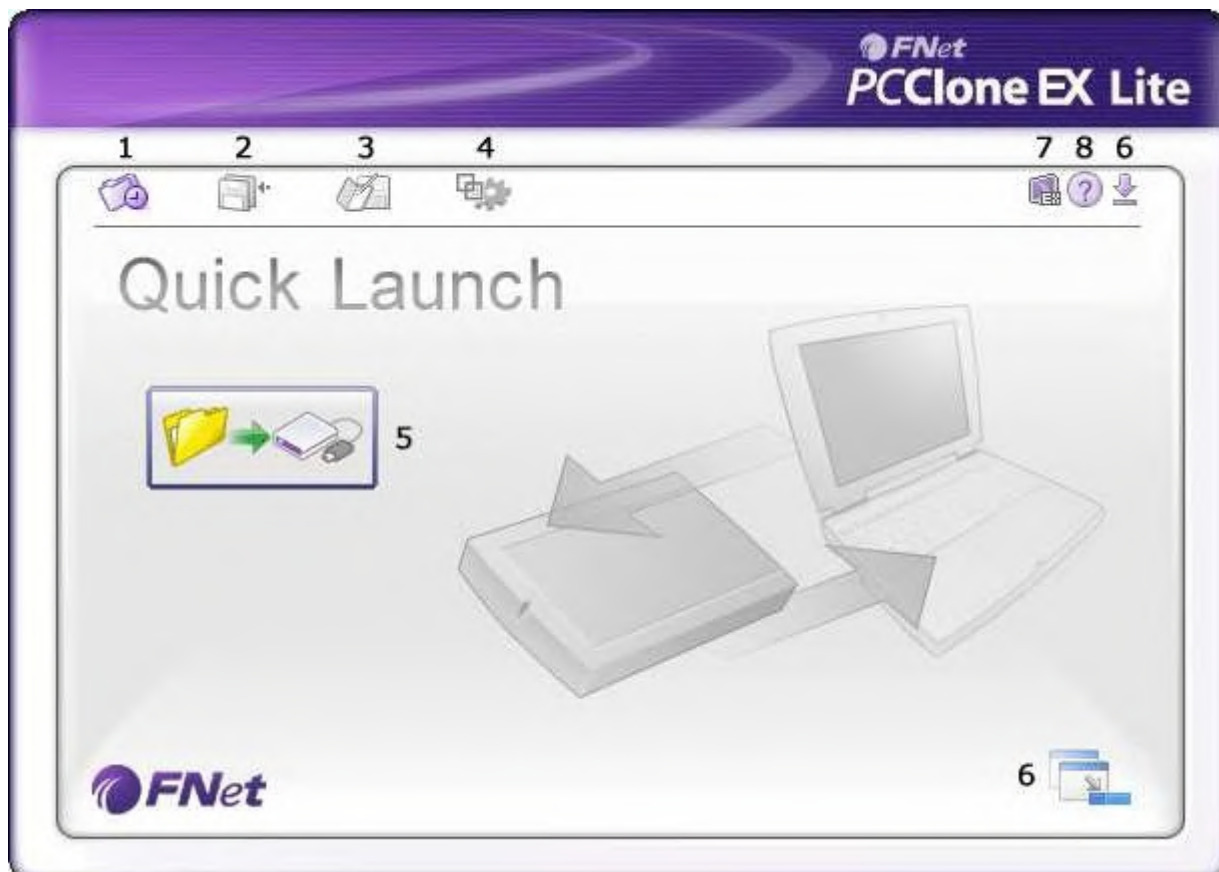


5. When the backup is in progress, PCClone EX Lite diagram will be blinking at the notification area. There is a dialog box will be displayed the progress every single 10 percentages.



6. After the backup is completed, PCClone EX Lite diagram at notification area will appear the Backup finished.

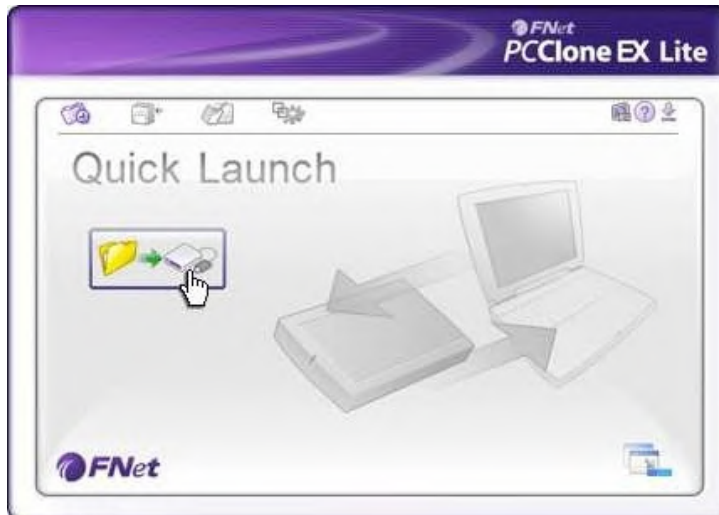

Quick File Backup

Quick launch is designed as a shortcut for users to backup folder(s)/file(s) with one click or user defined hotkey. The system will back up selected entities upon executing quick launch function. For first time use, please refer to [File Backup](#) session for selecting preferred files to back up and [File Backup Setting](#) for hotkey setup.



1. Please make sure that USB HDD is connected to the host computer and its power is ON.
2. Execute PCClone EX Lite.
3. Click on [Quick Launch](#) tab.
4. Click on [Quick File Backup](#) or press the hotkey combinations to backup selected folder(s)/file(s).

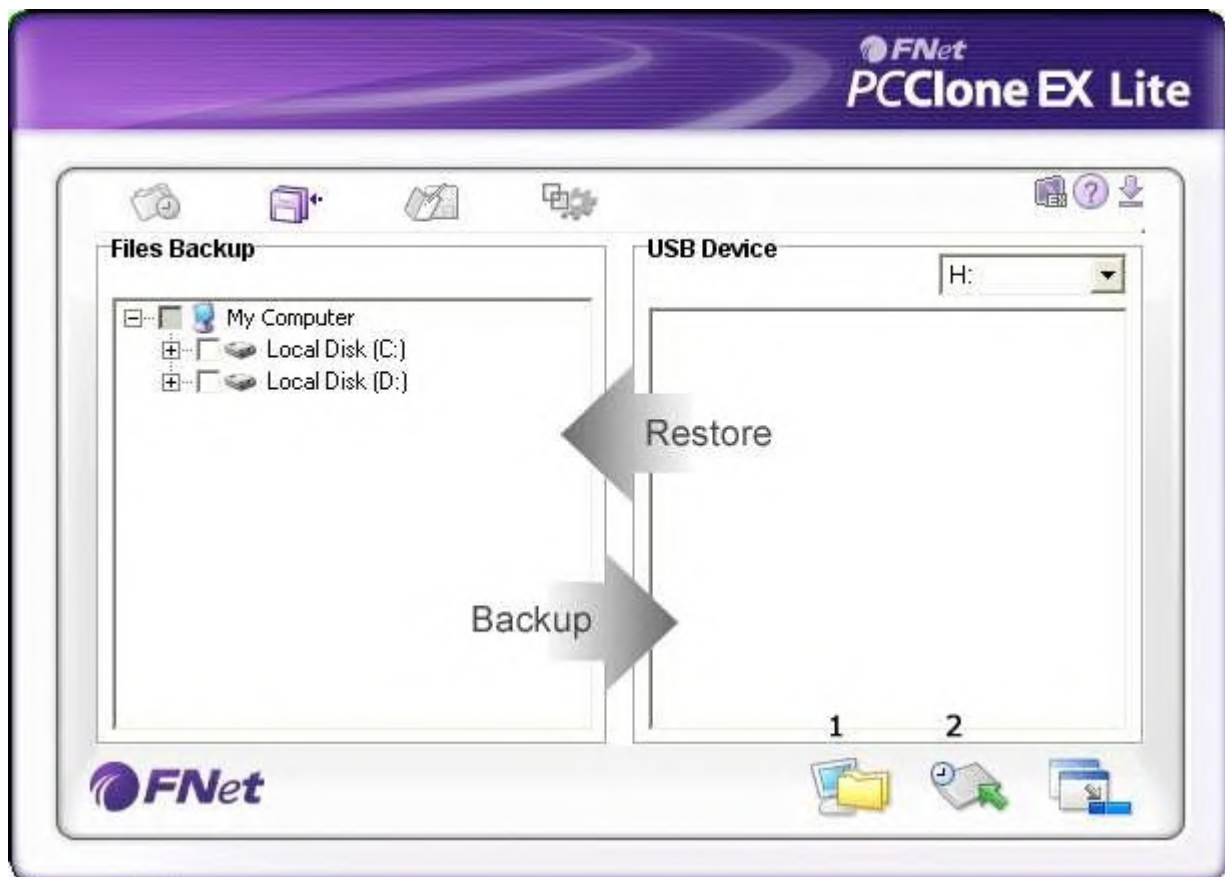


5. A dialog box will pop up requesting backup confirmation. Click [Start](#) to proceed and [Cancel](#) to cancel action.

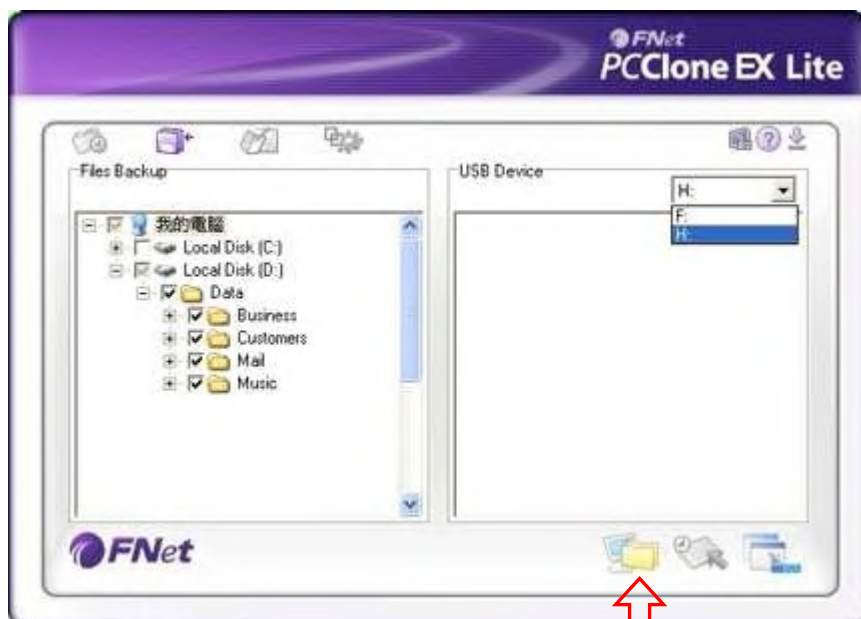


6. Another dialog box will pop up confirming back up action completion. Click [OK](#) to exit.

File Backup



1. Backup.
2. Restore.



1. Please make sure that USB HDD is connected to the host computer and its power is ON.
2. Execute PCClone EX Lite.
3. Click on File Backup tab to specify Backup/Restore paths
4. Under Files Backup column, place check mark(s) at the file(s)/folder(s) that are to be backed up.
5. Under USB Device column, click on the drop down box to select designated back up storage device.



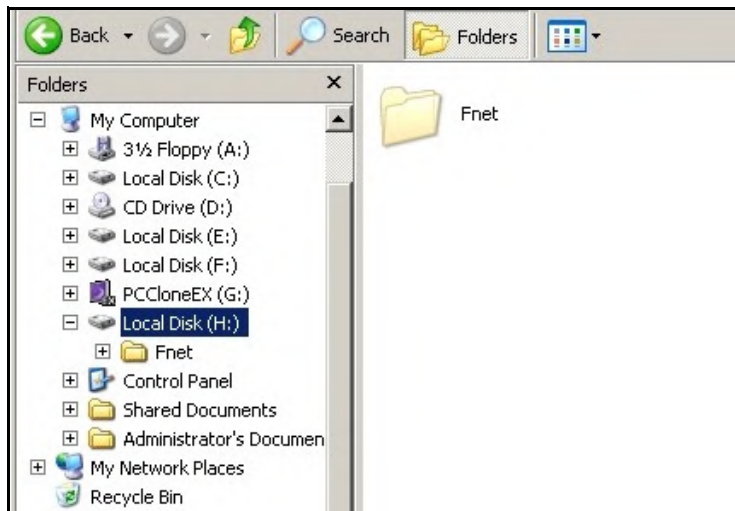
6. Click on Backup to start backup process. A dialog box will pop up confirming action. Please click on Start to continue and press Cancel to cancel action.



7. Another dialog box will pop up when the process is completed. Please click OK to exit.

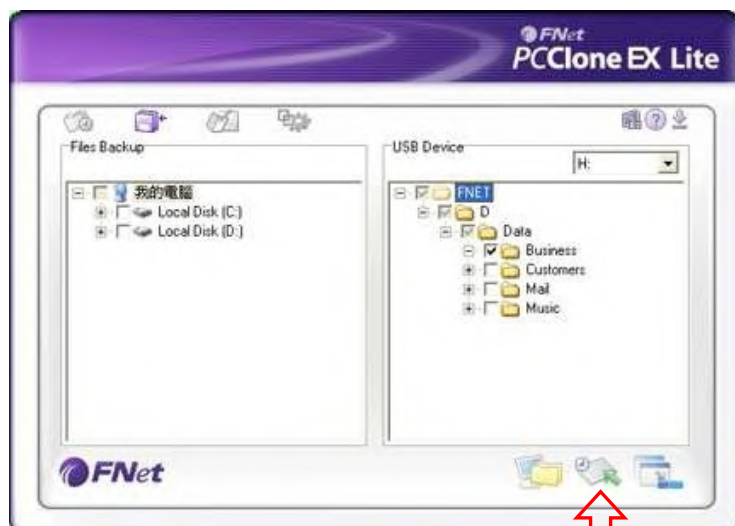


8. The selected file(s)/folder(s) have been backed up from the host computer to USB HDD successfully.



9. **Warning:** There is a hidden root directory F: FNet in the USB HDD. All the backup file(s)/folder(s) will be kept in this directory. Please do not remove the directory.

File Restore



1. Please make sure that USB HDD is connected to the host computer and its power is ON.
2. Execute PCClone EX Lite.
3. Click on File Backup tab to specify Backup/Restore paths
4. Under USB Device column, select folder(s)/file(s) that are ready to be restored.



5. Click on Restore to start restoring process. A dialog box will pop up confirming action. Please click on Start to continue and press Cancel to cancel action.

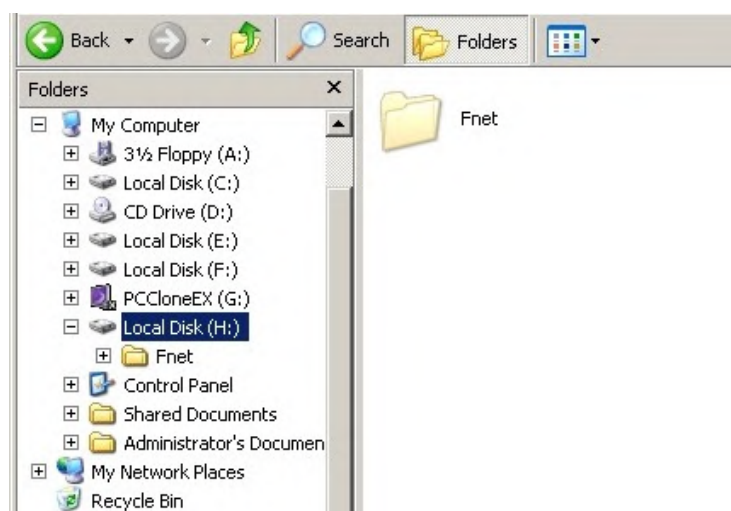


6. Another dialog box will pop up when the process is completed. Please click OK to exit.

Erase File Backup

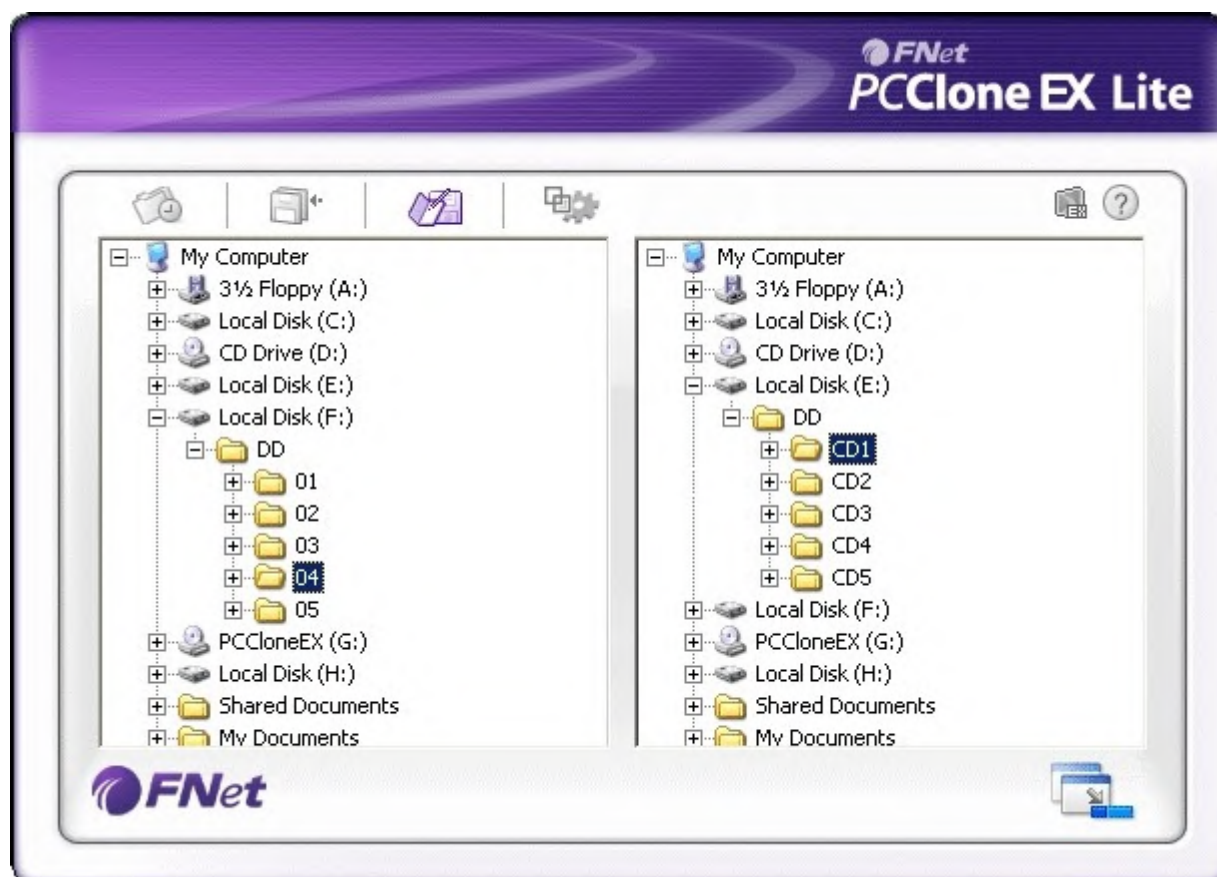


1. Please make sure that USB HDD is connected to the host computer and its power is ON.
2. Execute PCClone EX Lite.
3. Click on File Backup tab to display backup information.
3. Under USB Device, right click on the folder(s)/file(s) that are no longer needed and click Delete select files to remove them.



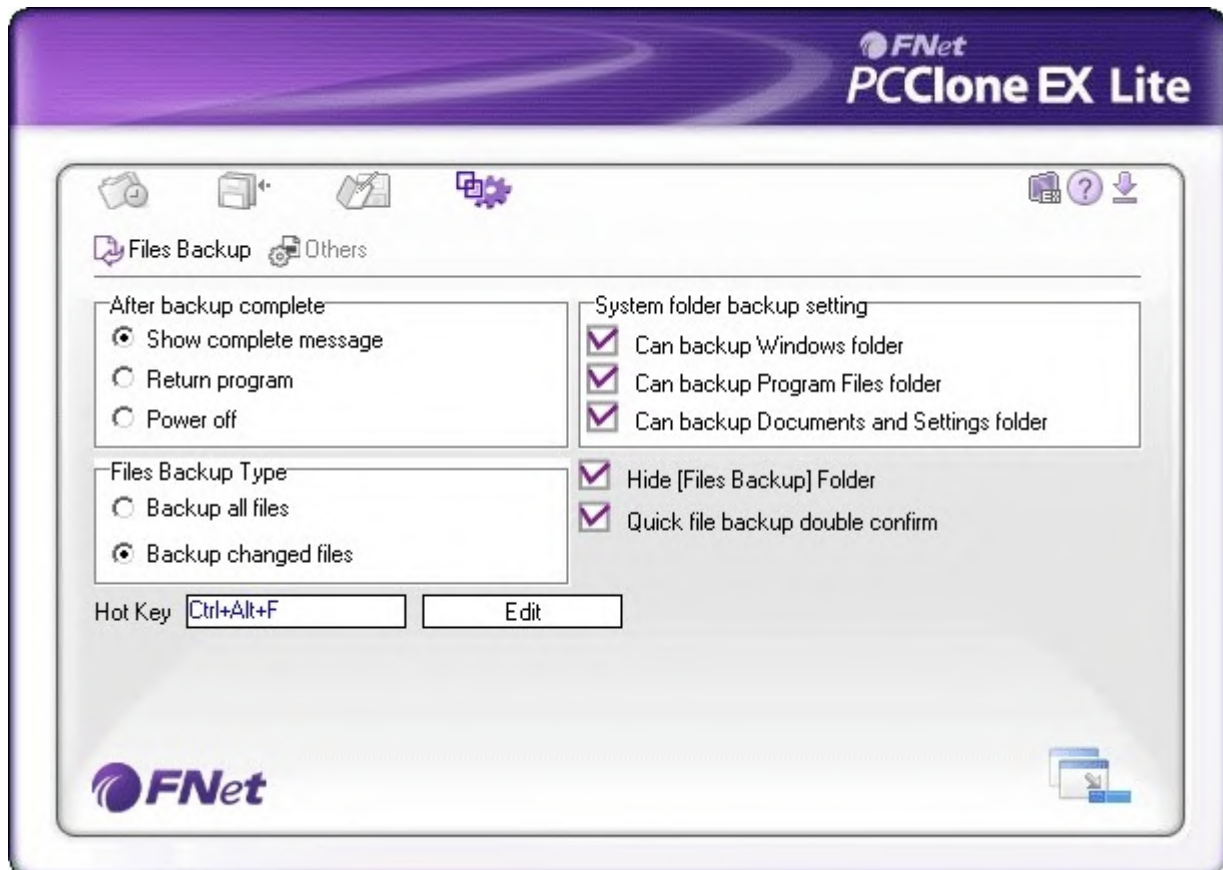
4. Backup folder(s)/file(s) can also be deleted at Windows file manager. Simply remove the Fnet root directory.

File Manager



PCClone EX Lite File Manager is the same function as Windows Explorer. PC Users is free to drag folder(s)/file(s) back and forth between the host computer hard drive and USB HDD. It is a feature designed for users to manage their folder(s)/file(s) without having to use Windows Explorer or My Computer.

File Backup setting



After backup complete

System activity after successful backup. Select Show complete message to pop up confirmation dialog box, Return program to return to program, and Power off to close program.

File Backup Type

Backup file options. Select Backup all files to back up all files in the directory and Backup changed files to back up files with modifications only.

Hot Key

When Edit button is clicked, a dialog box will pop up requesting user to input new hotkey combinations. Hold down any two of the following keys (Shift, Ctrl, and Alt) and another key to create new Hot Key. Click Yes to continue, Cancel to cancel.

System folder backup setting

Defining restrictions of backup file type. Click on Can backup Windows folder to allow windows file backup, Can backup Program Files folder to allow Program Files folder backup, and Can backup Documents and Settings folder to allow Documents and Settings folder backup.

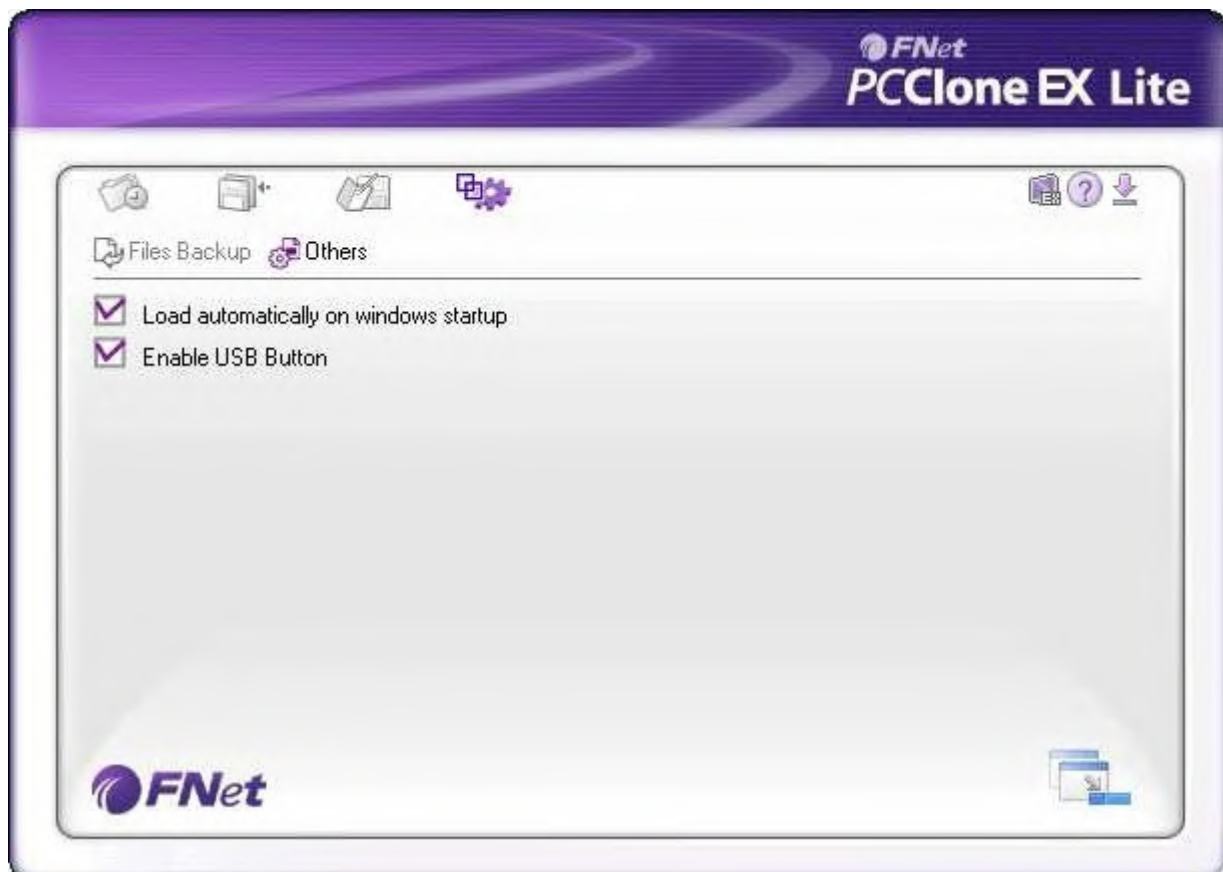
Hide [Files Backup] Folder

Click on this option to hide Files Backup folder.

Quick file backup double confirm

This option is check marked by default. When backup folder(s)/file(s) using hotkey, a dialog box will pop up requesting confirmation. Uncheck if necessary.

Others



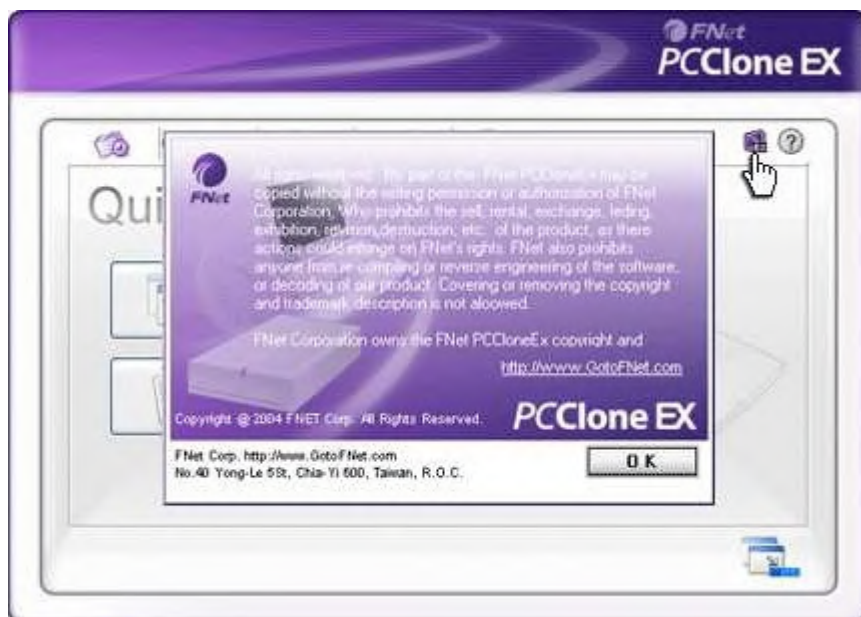
Load automatically on windows startup

This option will allow PCClone EX Lite to load automatically when window starts. Uncheck if necessary.

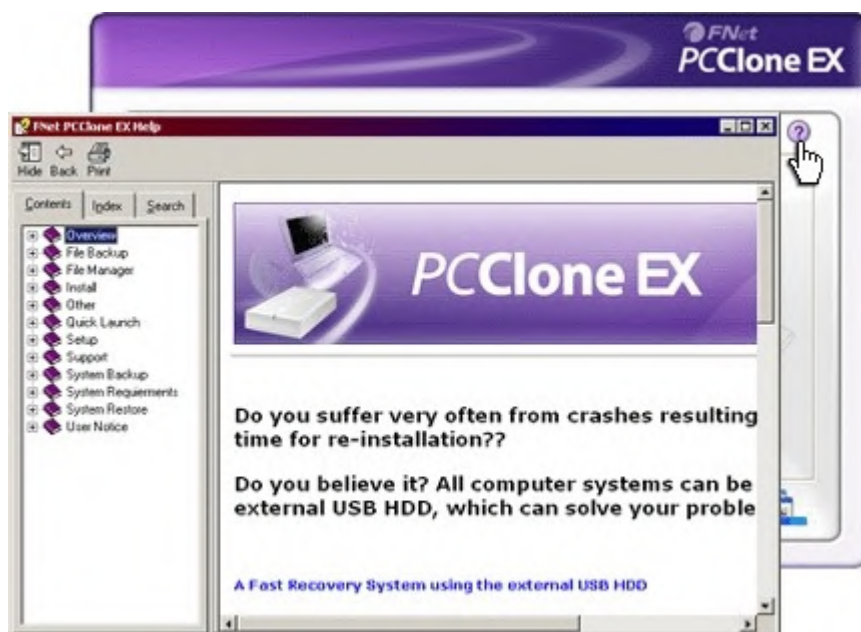
Enable USB Button

Click on this option to enable OTB button for quick backup service. Uncheck to disable OTB button function.
